- Pupils may bring a small, personal -use hand sanitizer and moisturiser daily if he wishes.

Notes:

- Textbooks marked * are available through the school's Book Rental Scheme, for the school year (nominal fee) and returned in perfect condition in June. All other books are workbooks, bought by parents, into which children write.
- It is essential to label all jumpers and jackets, as then we can return property to pupils when found.
- Please ensure that your child has all his books for September and all copies, journal and personal books are covered, with his <u>name on the front</u>. Otherwise, they become tattered and unsightly as the year progresses.
